Qualifications and Guidelines

Registration is complimentary for professional journalists who are attending the event to provide editorial coverage. Please follow the process below to register for press credentials. Press credentials will allow you access to the Opening Session, Keynote presentations, Welcome Reception, Technical Sessions and the Expo.

Press credentials are given to members of the working press whose attendance at the conference may result in coverage, whether print or broadcast, of the efforts of NSC and its members.

You must be currently employed by a publication with a general circulation *or* you must be currently employed with a recognized network, cable, independent news organization. You will be required to submit credential information (company business card) to support your qualifications along with your completed registration form. The NSC's Communications department will contact you upon receipt.

The deadline for advance media registration at the NSC 2008 Congress & Expo is August 22. Media registering in advance will receive an e-mail confirmation of their registration. Press badges will not be mailed to you. Press badges will be in the NSC Press Room beginning at 12:00 pm on Sunday, September 21.
