Media credentials are given to members of the working news media whose conference participation may result in coverage of NSC and its members.

You must be employed by a publication with a general circulation or by a recognized network, cable, online or independent news organization. You will be required to submit credential information (company business card) to support your qualifications along with your completed registration form. NSC's Communications Department will contact you upon receipt.
